Department of Atomic Energy has instituted DAE - Science Research Council Outstanding Investigator (DAE-SRC-01) Award Scheme to augment support to meritorious individual researchers (Scientists and engineers) with highly innovative ideas and with proven abilities to pursue advanced research in frontier areas of science and engineering in their respective field of interest to DAE, to be experimented. The award will carry research grant of up to Rs. One crore spread over a period of five years to be used for the sole purpose of pursuing the research project. Besides research grant, the awardees will be paid an incentive of Rs.25, 000/- per month for five years in addition to salary that they draw from their employer, subject to certain conditions. All the Heads of R&D Units of DAE and Aided Institutions are requested to kindly give wide publicity to the above said scheme in their Unit/Institution through e-communication and also by uploading in respective web-site. DAE Science Research Council Awards

A challenging opportunity to young scientists and engineers, who have proven track record in their respective field, to satiate their innovative ideas and pursue advanced research in an accelerated pace.

Applications are invited from these scholars for the "DAE-Science Research Council Outstanding Investigators" (DAE-SRC-OI) Awards for the year 2014.

The award includes a research grant of up to ₹ one crore spread over a period of five years which shall be used for the sole purpose of pursuing the research project submitted. The Award is tenable only for a maximum period of five years.

Eligibility: Individual scientists/engineers of the DAE constituent units, as well as those outside DAE, working in public funded institutions are eligible to apply for these awards. The applicants are expected to have demonstrated a high level of competence. The applicant should be below 47 years as on 31 December 2013.

Besides research grant, the awardees will be given an incentive of Rs. 25,000/- per month for five years in addition to the salary that they draw from their employer. In case the awardees are availing any other incentive from other agencies, they must choose only one.
