Currently she is a Walker Family Endowed Professor in Mathematics.

Her research interest is in Optimization and Applied Algebraic Geometry. She was an invited speaker at the International Congress of Mathematicians (ICM) in 2018. She has authored several books, including one in convex algebraic geometry and semidefinite optimization.
